Closing Ceremony Speech
FEI World Para-Equestrian Dressage Championships
Sunday 21 July 2007

Ladies and Gentlemen, Para Equestrian Athletes and newly crowned World Champions!

This is a proud moment in the history of the FEI. Hartpury 2007 has hosted the first ever World Para-Equestrian Dressage Championships to take place under the umbrella of the FEI - and boy have you needed an FEI umbrella this week! But seriously, by hosting this Championship, Hartpury has joined the Roll of Honour of historic competitions in Equestrian sport.

I am also particularly proud that the President of the International Paralympic Committee has joined us. Sir Philip Craven is the greatest ambassador for Paralympic sport and he is also a true friend to horsesport and to me personally. Thank you Sir Philip.

This World Championships has been a focus for competitive spirit and a living demonstration of the bond between nations and on behalf of the FEI and you the athletes I would like to thank everyone involved for their outstanding work in producing this truly memorable Championships.

The work of the team here to keep this show going has been extraordinary and I was particularly touched to hear that the riders in the CDI had volunteered to cancel their competition realising the importance of the World Championship to all of you.
